- Finance office – small and not adequate to accommodate number of people with no heat or air; not able to lock door with three people in room
- Classrooms – not enough weekdays and weekends with scouts, circles, confirmation classes
- Would request no glass walls

2) Please list any facility-related shortcomings of our current building that prevent your or inhibit your group from doing its activities.

- No heat or air in areas
- Kitchen in fellowship hall area is too small; poorly organized for more than 2 people
- Open area under counter/cabinets in fellowship kitchen – rodent area
- Inoperable sink faucets
- Rest rooms closer to activity areas
- School needs separate rest room
- Library not open to be able to use – locked; not able to check out books
- Need secure area for AV equipment
- Not readily accessible for handicap to deliveries in all areas – only one ramp

- Rollout panels – soundproof to divide large areas into smaller areas

 - Library furniture should be functional, mobile, comfortable – no sofas

 - The library is currently used as a prep room for brides – totally inadequate – no mirrors, outlets for dryers and curling irons, lighting inadequate for make up
 - There is no bereavement room (or something close) the library also serves this function and it does not have a “warm and welcoming” feel
 - If there could be a meeting room, it should not be confused with, used as or turned into a classroom
 - If there is to be a school – it should have its own restrooms (for children), kitchen area for snacks and /or refreshments (and not confused with church meeting rooms.)

1) What church facilities do you currently use for your activities and what specifically do you do in them?

- cubs and Boys use McSwain Center and 2 downstairs classrooms – Weekly, Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Regular Meetings, occasionally lock-ins, merit badge colleges, pack meetings, pinewood derby, court of honors and blue & gold celebrations
- Girls use #114 & #117 – 2nd, 4th, and 5th Tuesdays, 6:30-7:30pm
- Regular Meetings
- Circle: Mc Combs for funeral dinners, OWLS and Sunday School rooms

2) Please list any facility-related shortcomings of our current church that prevent or inhibit your group from doing its activities.

- cubs need to have 6 different classrooms for meetings – currently have to rotate out two groups in the classrooms and then the others have to meet in corners of the McSwain center and that is not conducive to each group maintaining the attention of the young boys. However, some meetings have physical activity and the gym is a great place to do that, so having that access is great.
- girls would like bigger rooms - #114 is kind of small and they cannot touch anything
- rooms away from the other meeting groups would be nice – sometimes the girls meetings can be loud and there are other groups and it's frustrating to always be after the girls to be quiet
- need access to a larger room for ceremonies – Cubs in the gym at same time, so cannot use that and AA in McCombs
- would like to have kitchen access during meetings and the ability to host dinners for families sometimes
- 1st Baptist has an activity center that allows multiple things to be done, having more rooms with different functions would be a great asset
- like having a central area for the group things like blue & gold and the pinewood derby, etc – would be nice to have set up in a spool type layout, center area with rooms around it
- audio-visual equipment to use for group meetings and ceremonies would be wonderful. Ones that are set up and ready to go would be VERY useful
- dedicated storage downstairs for easier access – especially for larger/heavier items.
- would like to have locks on their cabinets – things are disappearing and being used and returned broken
- for winter activities – low lighting in the courtyard for the ground area for walking
- stage type area with lights and audio-visual and microphones – somewhere that leaders could be highlighted
- easier building access – hard to share one key with regulars – keycode access would be wonderful
- ways to publish the scouts activities and availability to the congregation, to let the members know we have troops
- Interruption of meetings for WIHN, church events – while they are understandable, they are not always the easiest to work around, if they had access to other rooms/areas could work around better
- would like rooms without carpet for easier cleanup
- would like to be able to show off their art work or projects within the building
- circle needs keys to get in on Saturdays
- circle would like an ice machine in McCombs for funeral dinners and OWLS
- new and modern kitchen
- new and modern bathrooms – designed BY and for women
- more enthusiastic greeters
- an actual welcome center, visitor parking

- If we were better "advertised" with communications and allowed to do more around the church, it would allow members to participate

- by doing more with the groups, be more in the loop, might make the church more attractive to visitors
- feeling more welcome in the church would make boys more willing to participate in functions and events – feeling more important and part of the family (currently scouts feel that lots is blamed on them and they are not welcome because they are the first ones to be booted for events)
- scouts want to do service and a big part of it is for their meeting place, but they are overlooked – could be a huge asset to projects if allowed.
- girls would like to grow with a level for each age group, would love to be able to advertise through church and get church members – then the girls and the church could do functions together – cross generations
